

GOLF TOURNAMENT RULES

Best Ball Scramble

- Each player tees off. The team picks the best drive, marks the spot and all
 players hit from that spot. The ball may be set up to 1 club length from the
 marked spot, but NO CLOSER TO THE HOLE.
- This format is followed until the ball is holed.
- Each player must contribute 2 drives out of the 18 holes.
- Bogey is the maximum score. If your team misses the par putt, pick up the ball, add a stroke, and move to the next hole.
- If the team has only 3 players, 1 player may hit in place of the 4th player. The team must rotate which player takes the 4th player's role

Tee Box

Men 70+ & Women: hit from red tees
Men 55 – 69: hit from yellow tees
Men 54 and under: hit from white tees

Exception: Hole in One Contest (Hole #2): The line on the tee box is 150 yards from hole, and all players must hit behind the line

Putting Contest: 3 putts/\$10

• For each putt that lands inside the circle, you get one chance in the drawing to win the putting contest prize

Mulligans: Limit 4/team

- 1 Mulligan allows 1 golfer a do-over
- Cannot be used on the green
- May not be used to win the longest drive, closest to the pin or hole-in-one contests

String-it-out: Limit: 4 1' sections/team

- BEFORE a stroke, team can use 1, 2, 3 or 4 sections to remove the ball from a hazard or to putt the ball into the cup
- 1' section can be used individually or combined with other sections
- Once used, a string cannot be re-used
- NO STROKE IS RECORDED WHEN USING A STRING



GOLF TOURNAMENT CONTESTS

Survivor Ball

- Each team receives 1 Survivor Ball
- Survivor Ball must be played by a different player for an entire hole
- Return the Survivor Ball at the end of play for a chance to win the prize

Hole #2 - Hole in One Sponsored by R.F. Moeller

- A line drawn on the tee box is 150 yards from the hole
- All players must tee off behind the line
- No Mulligans
- Professionals cannot participate in the contest

Hole # 6 - Longest Drive – Women

 If your shot is longer than earlier golfers, move the stake to where your ball stopped and write your name on the sheet

Hole #9 - Longest Putt - Men and Women

• If your putt is longer than earlier golfers, move the stake to where your ball was before you putted and write your name on the sheet

Hole # 14 - Closest to the Pin - Men and Women

- Be the golfer that hits their tee shot closest to the hole
- If your shot is closer than earlier golfers, move the stake to where your ball stopped and write your name on the sheet

Hole # 17 - Longest drive - Men

• If your shot is longer than earlier golfers, move the stake to where your ball stopped and write your name on the sheet
